

Journey Kids COVID-19 Guidelines

*guidelines created based on [Comprehensive Considerations for Reopening Churches](#) (Georgia Baptist Mission Board) and common sense (Chassidy Hoffman)

Class Size (determined by size of classroom/ability to maintain social distance):

- Factory- 15 kids
- Pathfinders 3&4: 5 kids
- Pathfinders 1&2: 3 kids
- Nursery not staffed at this time

Check

in:

- ONE volunteer checking in families
- NO ONE except Journey Kids volunteers and Journey Kids are allowed beyond check in station. This includes usage of downstairs bathroom.
- Handsanitizer should be sitting at station and used after each check in

Classrooms:

- Volunteers should arrive by 10:30 to clean and disinfect prior to children arriving
- There should NOT be any children in any classroom prior to 10:40
- All toys, crayons, scissors, markers (all shared items in general) should be removed from classrooms
- Factory classroom will remove every other chair to encourage Journey Kids to maintain social distance
- Hand Sanitizer and Lysol disinfectant will be available in every classroom
- At the end of class, sweep classroom, lysol doorknobs and hard surfaces (including tables and chairs)
- Checklist of items to disinfect will be posted in each classroom

Restrooms:

- Journey Kids should be monitored to make sure they wash hands after using the restroom and prior to returning to class
- Lysol should be available to disinfect sink, toilet, doorknob, toilet paper holder, soap canister and light switch after each use
- Children's Director will disinfect downstairs bathroom at the end of service
