EACH DAY: DO THE FOLLOWING WITH EACH PART OF SCRIPTURE PRESENTED:

### 1 PETER 2:18-21 (NLT)

#### Slaves

<sup>18</sup> You who are slaves must submit to your masters with all respect. <sup>19</sup> Do what they tell you—not only if they are kind and reasonable, but even if they are cruel. <sup>20</sup> For God is pleased when, conscious of his will, you patiently endure unjust treatment. <sup>21</sup> Of course, you get no credit for being patient if you are beaten for doing wrong. But if you suffer for doing good and endure it patiently, God is pleased with you.

<sup>21</sup> For God called you to do good, even if it means suffering, just as Christ suffered <sup>22</sup> for you. He is your example, and you must follow in his steps.

1. Handwrite the scripture by copying it in the space provided.
2. Observe what the Scripture is saying. Do not add or take away from it. Simply write out what it is saying.
3. Answer the questions provided so that you may apply the scripture to your life.
